EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This is a written companion of D8.5, a conference.

1. INTRODUCTION

A conference was held on June 26-30 in Munich. Below we describe the meeting, our role, and the follow-ups.

2. THE CONFERENCE (HHAI)

At the 2023 Summer School the project decided to take the lead in the organization of (https://hhai-conference.org/2023/), the Hybrid Human Artificial Intelligence (HHAI) conference. The meeting was held in Munich, 26-30 June 2023. We strategically see this conference as a "project legacy" which will ensure that the scientific community we have built through the project will live on after its ends, since such conferences are what defines and holds together scientific communities.

At the same time, during the project runtime, the conference attracts a mix of researchers from the HCI, AI and even computational social science to our project ensuring growth beyond the project members.







Thus the latest (second) edition of the conference had that HumanE AI Net and fully organized it had 78 submissions, with 14 accepted as long, 14 short "working papers" and 7 extended abstracts (43% acceptance rate). The conference had 179 attendees (37% of that students) from 27 countries and over 100 different affiliations, with the majority being from outside our project.

The first edition was driven by the Dutch Hybrid Intelligence consortium in Amsterdam (with a support from HumanE AI Net) and was much more dominated (much more than the half) by participants from within the two consortia. For the next year the HHAI will be organized together with the Swedish TAIGA AI initiative and the following year the Italian AI initiative will take over.

The Science4Imapet Night on day three was an innovation event co-organized by WP7 AI Innovation Networking – Founders4impact night, with 70+ attendees, 3 table leaders from Science, Venture Capital and Social Entrepreneurship, 12 Startup Pitches.
